ATTENDANCE/TRUANCY

Attendance in school is critical to student learning, but on occasion students need to miss. ANY TIME YOUR CHILD IS ABSENT FROM SCHOOL, the law states that you must notify the school. If there is no answer, please leave a message with your name and relationship, as well as the reason for the absence

Absences are considered TRUANT unless a signed, written note by the parent/guardian or medical excuse from a doctor with the reason for the absence is received within 24 hours for a legitimate reason. See the Student Handbook for additional information.
